




The Short Version

How did the COVID-19 pandemic impact jobs and employment in Niagara?




78.8% of Niagara's total employment losses were among individuals doing sales and service work

80.3% of Niagara's total employment losses were found in two industry sectors: accommodation and food service and wholesale and retail trade Amid the challenges, increased job demand in Q1/Q2 2021 shows some signs of tentative steps toward recovery



Almost three-quarters of employers responding to a recent business survey reported **stable or better business conditions**. However, among tourism employers only slightly more than half could make the same claim.

Local employers reporting stable or better business conditions



As of March 2021, the number of Niagara residents employed in tourism supporting industries had fallen by more than half from 39,134 people prepandemic to 18,672. Preliminary analysis does suggest Niagara is seeing signs of a humble employment recovery in this sector, as well.
