POPULATION TRENDS

According to the 2021 Census, Lincoln was home to 25,719 people.

while women accounted for 50.9% in 2021 (Figure 1).




Figure 2: Income Group Statistics

INCOME Table 3 shows the median total income for individuals living in Lincoln for the year 2020. Women reported a median income of \$37,200 compared with \$54,400 for men. **Table 3: Median Total Income in 2020 Among Recipients**

In 2020, the plurality of Lincoln's residents was in the income group of \$50,000 to \$99,999, which increased by 22.2% since 2015. The income group of \$100,000 to \$149,000 saw the largest percentage increase of 62.7% between 2015 and 2020, whereas the income group of under \$10,000 (including loss) experienced the largest percentage decrease of 35.8% (**Figure 2**).





Tables 4 and 5 present occupation and industry job counts, wages, and location quotients (LQ). An LQ greater than 1.0 indicates that an occupation/industry is more concentrated in Lincoln relative to Ontario as a whole. **Table 4** shows the top occupations in Lincoln by the number of jobs in 2022.

Table 5 presents the top 5 largest industries in Lincoln by number of jobs in 2022. These jobs make up 26.6% of all jobs in Lincoln.
