
According to the 2021 Census, Niagara-on-the-Lake was home to 19,088

Figure 1: Population Breakdown, By Gender, Census 2016 vs. 2021



Table 3 shows the median total income for individuals living in Niagara-on-the Lake for the year 2020. Women reported a median income of \$37,600 compared with \$51,200 for men.



We estimate job demand through the aggregation of public-facing, online job postings. Between January 2023 and August 2023, there were 101 new online postings listed in Niagara-on-the-Lake. It may be the case that employers in Niagara-on-the-Lake use alternate methods of

Tables 4 and 5 present occupation and industry job counts, wages, and location quotients (LQ). An LQ greater than 1.0 indicates that an occupation/industry is more concentrated in Niagara-on-the-Lake relative to Ontario as a whole.

of all jobs in the Niagara region. Niagara-on-the-Lake gained 989 jobs (or 9.8%), between 2021 and 2022. This level of job growth was higher than the regional job growth of 7.2% during the same time (see **Figure 5**).
