POPULATION TRENDS

According to the 2021 Census, Pelham was home to 18,192 people.



Table 3 shows the median total income for individuals living in Pelham for the year 2020. Women reported a median income of \$40,000 compared with \$57,200 for men.

In 2020, the plurality of Pelham's residents was in the income group of \$50,000 to \$99,999, which increased by 14.4% since 2015. The income group of \$150,000 and over saw the largest percentage increase of 44.5% between 2015 and 2020, whereas the income group of under \$10,000 experienced the largest percentage decrease (-31.3%; Figure 2).

JOB DEMAND

We estimate job demand through the aggregation of public-facing, online job postings. Between January 2023 and August 2023, there were **714 new job postings** listed in Pelham. The five most common occupations listed in Pelham's job postings are shown in Figure 3.



In 2022, there were 6,045 jobs in Pelham, representing 3.1% of all jobs in Niagara. Pelham gained 457 jobs (or 8.2%), between 2021 and 2022. This level of job growth was higher than the regional job growth of 7.2% during the same time (see **Figure 5**).
