





In 2020, the plurality of St. Catharines' residents was in the income group of \$10,000 to \$29,999, which decreased by 11.6% since 2015. The income group under \$10,000 (including loss) experienced the largest percentage decrease of 45.8% (Figure 2).






We estimate job demand through the aggregation of public-facing, online job postings. Between January 2023 and August 2023, there were 9,450 **new job postings** listed in St. Catharines. The five most common occupations listed in St. Catharines's job postings are shown in Figure 3.

In 2022, there were 59,677 jobs in St. Catharines, representing 31% of all jobs in Niagara. St. Catharines gained 3,470 jobs (or 6.2%), between 2021 and 2022. This level of job growth was lower than the regional job growth of 7.2% during the same time. These data are shown in **Figure 5**.
