According to the 2021 Census, Thorold was home to 23,816 people.





In 2020, the plurality of Thorold's residents was in the income group of \$10,000 to \$29,999, which increased by 9.5% between 2015 and 2020. During that time, income group under \$10,000 (including loss) experienced the largest percentage decrease of 33.8% (Figure 2).




