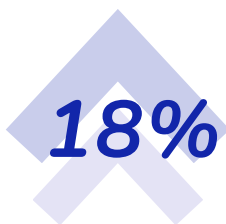
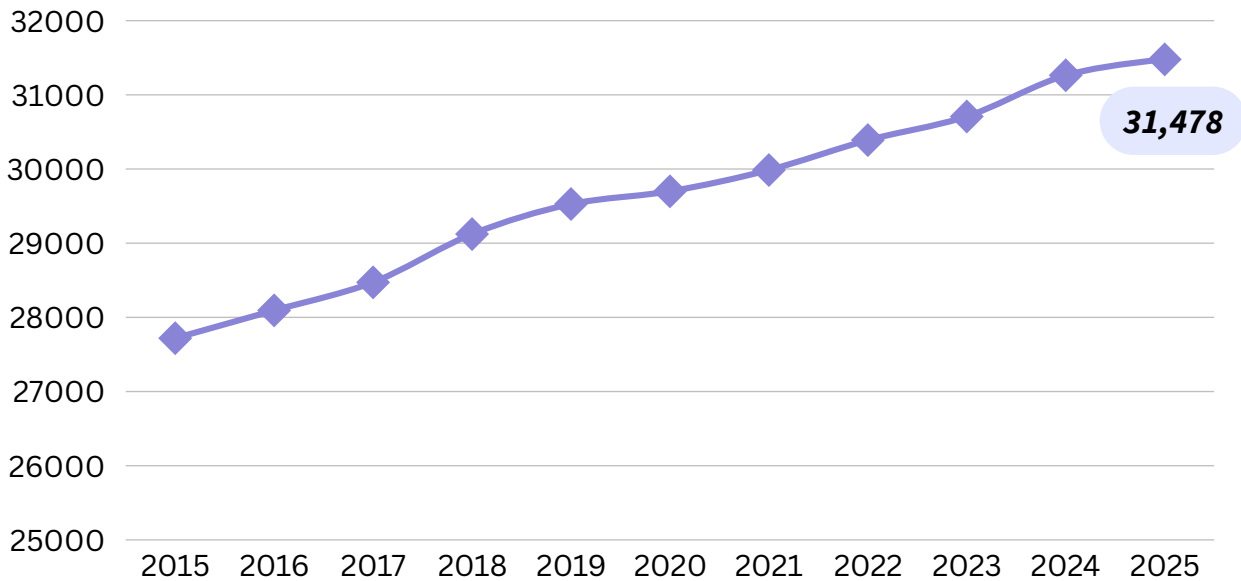


Grimsby

Population Trends, 2015-2025

Grimsby's population grew by 0.7% annually and has grown by 13.6% over the past 10 years. From tax filers data, the median total income (individual) for Grimsby in 2022 was \$46,310.

Job Posts and Employers, 2025

Data from Jan-Dec 2025 shows that there were a total of 1,602 new job posts and 417 companies hiring in Grimsby. In-demand occupations include store shelf stockers and clerks, retail salespersons and visual merchandisers, and food service jobs.
