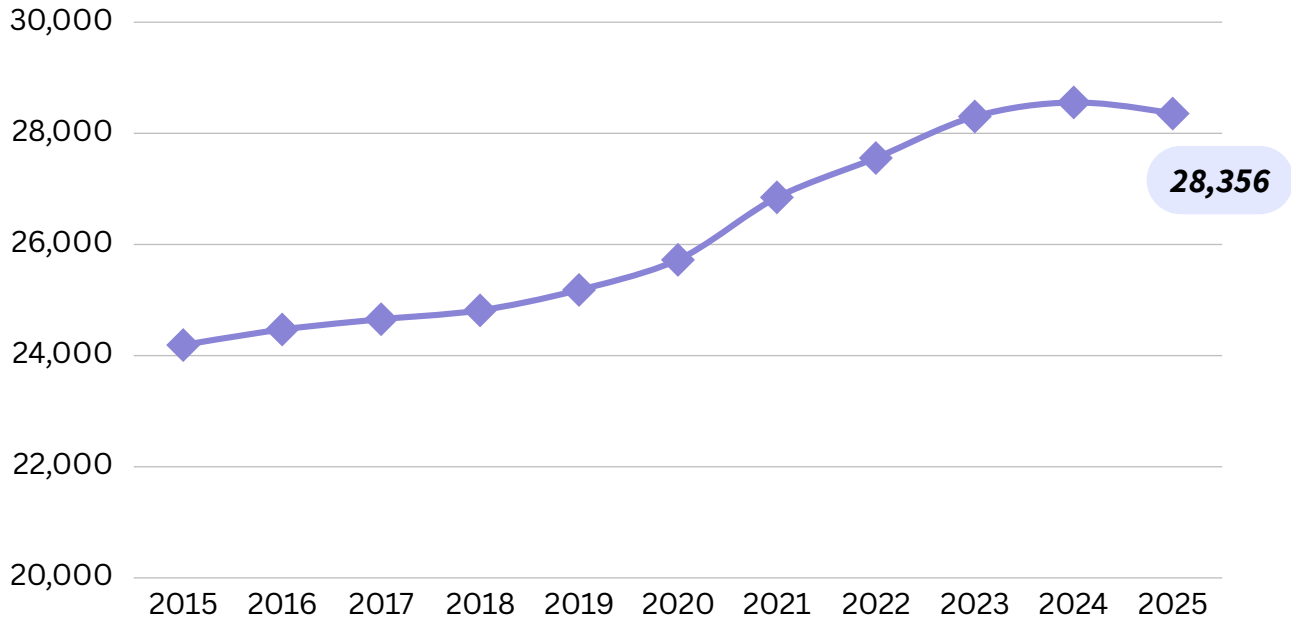


Lincoln

Population Trends, 2015-2025

Lincoln’s population declined slightly by 0.7% annually and has grown by 17.2% over the past 10 years. From tax filers data, the median total income (individual) for Lincoln in 2022 was \$36,390.

Job Posts and Employers, 2025

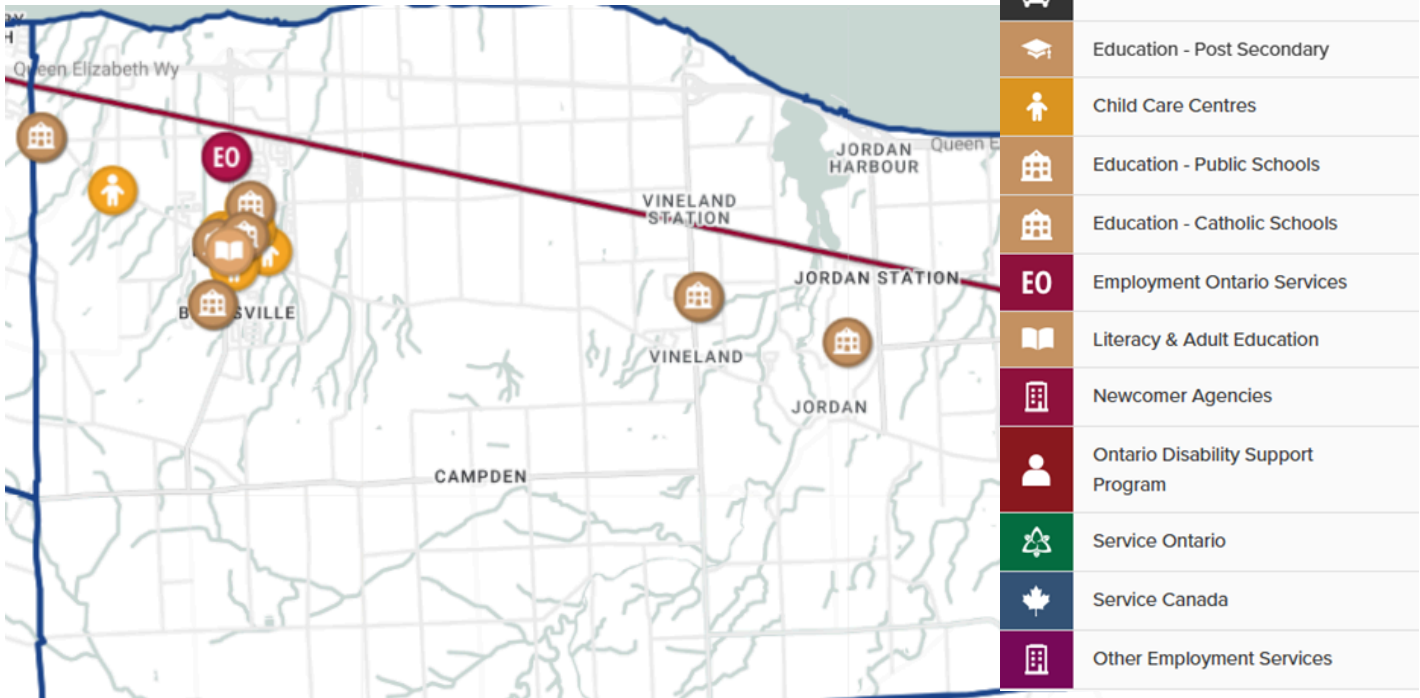
Data from Jan-Dec 2025 shows that there were a total of 1,408 new job posts and 386 companies hiring in Lincoln. In-demand occupations include social and community service workers, food service jobs, and home support workers and caregivers.
