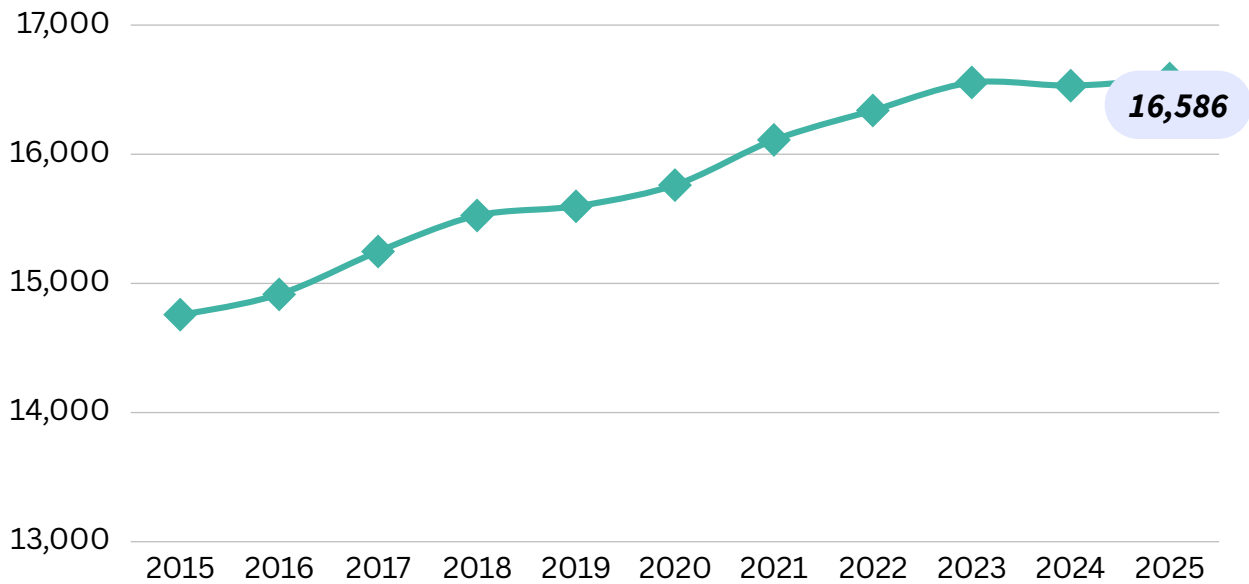


West Lincoln

Population Trends, 2015-2025

West Lincoln’s population grew by 0.3% annually and has grown by 12.4% over the past 10 years. From tax filers data, the median total income (individual) for West Lincoln in 2022 was \$41,860.

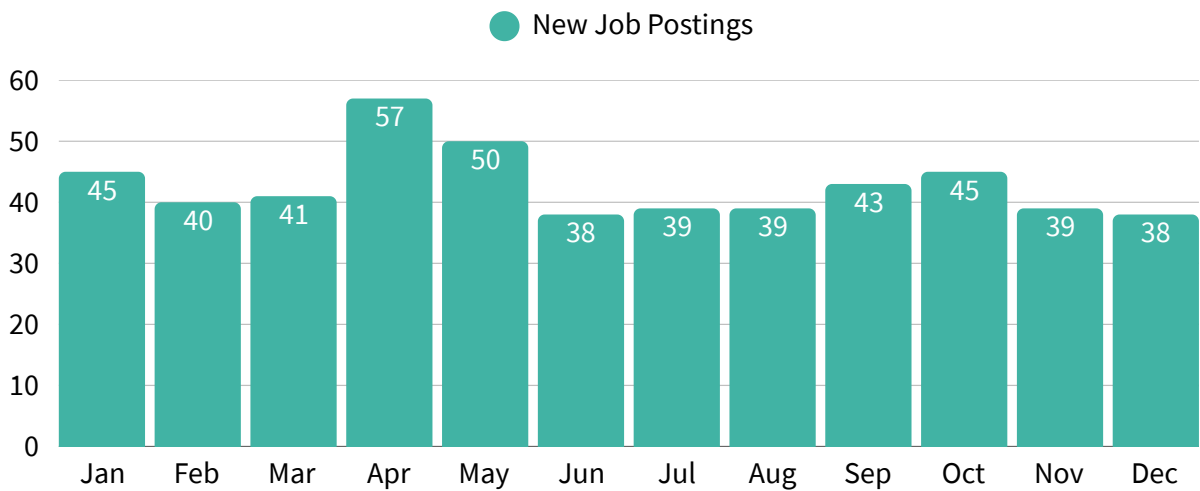

Job Posts and Employers, 2025

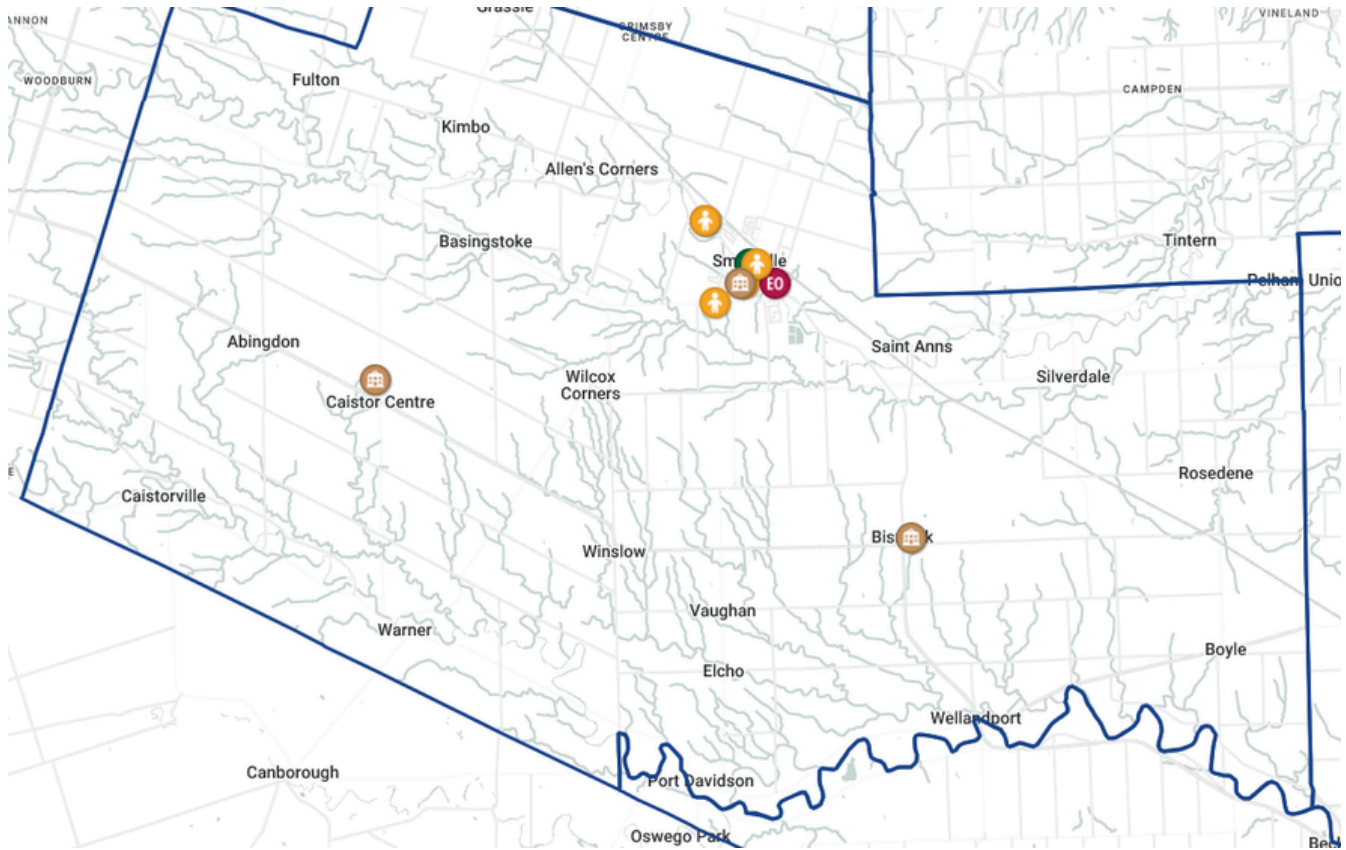


